Our Commitment to Safety

This event has a zero-tolerance policy for racism, transphobia, homophobia, sexism, harassment, and any form of violence. Clearly identified event staff will be available to address incidents. Depending on the situation, responses may include addressing harm through a call-in process or, if necessary, suspension or expulsion from the event without a refund.

Please note that while this event creates space for folks to discuss and unlearn racism, these conversations may be activating for some. Support will be available for those who need it with a quiet room for all attendees in addition to dedicated space/time for BIPOC attendees to gather.

Cancellations

We understand circumstances can change and we want to ensure attendees are able to plan accordingly.

- Cancellations received before April 4th will receive a 100% refund.
- Cancellations received before April 22nd will receive a 50% refund.
- Cancellations received on or after April 22nd will not be eligible for a refund but can still be transferred to another name.
